Highly Prized

In a 1648 sermon titled "Christ Is the Life of Believers," English preacher Thomas Brooks encouraged listeners to highly prize Jesus and to remember that he highly prizes us:

"You prize great ones; the Lord Jesus Christ is great — he is King of kings, and Lord of lords. You prize others for their wisdom and knowledge; the Lord Jesus hath in himself "all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge" (Colossians 2:3, KJV). You prize others for their usefulness; the Lord Jesus Christ is the right hand of a believer, without which he can do nothing.
