Married for a Mission

Jesus' command to seek first God's kingdom (Matthew 6:33) is a key component of successful, God-honoring marriages, writes Gary Thomas in A Lifelong Love (David C. Cook). In fact, Thomas says being "married for a mission" can renew many unions in which partners think they're merely incompatible. "My suspicion is that many of these couples actually suffer from a lack of purpose," he writes. "Jesus' words given to individuals in Matthew 6:33 are perhaps even truer in marriage. When we give away our life, we find it. When we focus outside our marriage, we end up strengthening our marriage."
