

As I approached a brightly lit, vertical floor plan at a mall, I noticed a woman standing in front of it for quite a while. “Can I help you find something?” I offered. As people scurried around us, she replied, “No, thanks. I’m just pausing for a moment.” Then, pointing to the arrow that announced, “You are here,” she said, “I need to be reminded sometimes.”

This coming Tuesday, Nov. 11th is Veteran's Day. It is the day we set aside to honor all who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces. The holiday originated as Armistice Day on Nov. 11th, 1919 the first anniversary of the end of World War I. In 1926 Congress passed a resolution for an annual observance and Nov. 11th became a National holiday in 1938. The name was officially changed from Armistice day to Veterans Day in 1954 by then President Eisenhower. In 1968 Congress passed the Uniform Holidays Bill which moved the holiday to the fourth Monday in October. In 1975 the President Ford move the holiday back to November 11th due to the important historical significance of the day. Make sure to thank a Veteran for their service to our Country this Tuesday.
